Reservations FOR SUMMER CAMP

Thank you for providing an estimated number of participants you expect to attend 2022 Camp Geronimo.

This information will help us plan and prepare for next summer.

Each troop that submits this information along with the \$200 deposit to Camp Headquarters or Council Headquarters NO LATER than the October 15, 2021 deadline will secure one free base camp adult (\$150 value).

This credit will be voided if the troop cancels their registration at any time.

\$200 site deposit is due with this application and is applied to the balance of fees in May 2022.

This deposit is fully refundable until December 31, 2021.

Payment Schedule: Information below is subject to change.

January 31	All units must submit a non-refundable deposit of \$125 for each youth attending merit badge camp by January 31st. If payment is not received by February 15 th , the troop's reservation will be cancelled. For Spade Ranch participants: \$200 For Fish Camp participants: \$150 For Drone Flight School participants: \$200	A non-refundable deposit of \$65 per adult leader is due by January 31st. Adults participating in Spade Ranch, Drone, or Fish Camp will follow the youth schedule. If not received by February 15th, the reservation will be canceled.

April 1	By April 1, units should submit an additional \$125 non-refundable fee for each youth participating. Failure to submit payment by April 15th, will result in the cancellation of your reservation. For Spade Ranch participants: \$200 For Fish Camp participants: \$125 For Drone Flight School participants: \$200	By April 1, units should submit an additional non-refundable fee for each adult participating in Spade Ranch, Drone, or Fish Camp following the youth fee schedule. Failure to submit payment by April 15th, will result in the cancellation of your reservation.
May 1	The balance of all camp fees is due by May 1st. Participants who do not pay by May 1st will be charged a \$50 late fee. Though fees are non-refundable at each payment stage, units may switch youth or adults without a penalty. For Spade Ranch participants: \$100 For Fish Camp participants: \$125 For Drone Flight School participants: \$200	An additional non-refundable payment of \$85 per adult is due by May 1 st .

Additions and Cancellations:

To cancel reservations or to change numbers of people attending, written notification is required to our Camp Registrar at gcc.program@scouting.org.

Units may switch youth for youth and adult for adult on the registration portal.

After January 31, 2022 each payment is non-refundable.

Refund Policy:

The GCC must commit financial resources to employ staff, purchase food and supplies, and prepare for summer operations. Participants are therefore also required to make a financial commitment to attend. **Be cautious of making reservations for those who have not made a financial commitment.** In cases of death of an immediate family member, infectious illness, debilitating injury, or military transfer, we will refund all but \$150 of fees paid when verified by a physician, military commander, or similar. Refund requests must be requested within two weeks of the scheduled reservation.
